

# SHARON'S FACELIFT U-TURN!

Stone vowed to **NOT** have surgery, now it seems she's changed her mind! – experts

**D**ID Sharon Stone have a nip and tuck?

Top plastic surgeons polled by The National ENQUIRER believe the answer is “yes” – after the 56-year-old actress was photographed wearing a black headband with a red rash under her right ear!

While a source close to Sharon said it is a burn, plastic surgeon **Dr. Lyle Back**, who has not treated the “Basic Instinct” star, told The ENQUIRER: “This appears to me to be a well-healed, mature, pale pink ... scar – quite characteristic and a classic sign of a previous facelift.

“Even the most well-done facelift leaves a cookie trail of some kind!”

Plastic surgeon Dr. Anthony Youn, who also has not treated Sharon, added: “The red patch of skin [under her ear] can be consistent with scarring from a facelift.”

Dr. Ben Johnson, founder of the Osmosis Pur Medical Skin-care line, agreed.

“The incision for a facelift goes just below the ear, and sometimes there are reactions to the sutures or other wound-related complications,” said Dr. Johnson, who has not treated the “Casino” star.

It's a major backflip for the leggy blonde beauty, who had previously claimed she's resisted going under the knife, saying she felt it was better to look her age and grow old gracefully.

“I can't tell you how many doctors try to sell me a facelift,” she said in a 2013 interview.

“I've even gone as far as having someone talk me into it, but when I went over and looked at pictures of myself, I thought, What are they going to lift?”

While admitting she'd “come

close” to undergoing cosmetic procedures, Sharon added: “Frankly, I think that in the art of aging well there's this sexuality to having those imperfections.”

She also told another interviewer: “If you want it [plastic surgery], you should have it.”

Sharon has admitted to having a lip injection after her 2004 divorce from newspaper editor Phil Bronstein, noting that she felt insecure about her looks at the time.

But after something was pumped into her bottom lip, Sharon claimed she looked “like a trout,” and vowed never to undergo another procedure.

But a source said: “Maybe this time Sharon finally just gave in and had the work done!”
