to the outer brow would give a much fresher, happier look — possible with more sophisticated Botox injections." Well-executed, though, is a nose job to correct an earlier, botched procedure, says Dr. Back. "They smartly avoided carving it down and creating the

classic Hollywood, ever-disappearing nose," he says. "By actually adding cartilage and rebuilding it, Carole looks much better (even though, if you look closely, you can see that her nose is technically bigger)." Sounds like award-worthy work, indeed. **LS**
