Since marrying Ice T (and starring on the reality show *Ice Loves Coco* from 2011 to 2013), Coco Austin has gone Hollywood — and so has her face! According to experts, the former model has graduated from self-tanner and lip gloss to Botox, filler injections and chemical peels. “It seems Coco has had Botox to smooth out her forehead lines,” says NYC plastic surgeon Kally Papantoniou, comparing the 37-year-old’s polished look to 13 years ago. The doc (who does not treat Coco) also thinks the star has had filler added to her lips

and cheeks, and Botox in her jaw area, based on the changed shape of her lower face. Plastic surgeon Dr. Norman Rowe agrees, adding laser resurfacing as a possible reason for Coco’s creamy skin (which dermatologist Dr. Neil Sadick, also not Coco’s doc, attributes to a “light chemical peel”). Whatever she’s doing, the glamour queen is keeping it all in perspective. “I’m really at peace in life,” beams the mom of Chanel, who turns 1 in November. “I don’t take it for granted!” ❧

FOREHEAD

Dr. Papantoniou speculates Botox is keeping Coco's forehead smooth. Regular injections can set you back anywhere from \$400 to \$1K per visit, says the doc.

NOSE

“The tip of Coco’s nose was prominent and bulbous,” says Dr. Lynn M. Back, who hasn’t treated her. “It’s been softened to yield a more feminine look.” Cost of rhinoplasty: \$6K.

CHEEKS

Coco likely gets her cheeks filled with Voluma, which needs to be refreshed every nine months to a year. The annual price tag for most facial injections is about \$5K.

LIPS

Coco’s now-filler lips have been plumped with Restylane or Juvederm at a cost of about \$1K per session, believes Dr. Back. Results generally last for about six months.
